#### **Workshop requirements:**

- 1. **Jacquard Knitting -** .You will need 8 ply yarn in at least 4 colours, 4 mm circular needles or a pair of single points.
- 2. **Macramé Plant Holder-** Cost \$6.00, cord, beads etc supplied. Please bring tape measure and scissors.
- 3. **Spinning with a Drop Spindle** bring a Drop Spindle if you have one and some rovings. Some spindles and rovings will be available at camp.
- 4. **Felted cowl -** Please bring 50 grams rovings in one colour, plus other colours and threads/fibre for decorations; a small amount of washing liquid, bottle for warm water, towel, net or old lace curtain or plastic sheeting, and piece of bubble wrap, all approx 1 metre long; piece of resist if you have it, scissors. Small amounts of yarn and bubble wrap will be available for purchase.
- 5. **Felted mittens beginner -** Please bring 50 grams rovings in one colour, plus other colours and threads/fibre for decorations; a small amount of washing liquid, bottle for warm water, towel, net or old lace curtain or plastic sheeting, and piece of bubble wrap, all approx 1 metre long; piece of resist if you have it, scissors. Small amounts of yarn and bubble wrap will be available for purchase.
- 6. **Crochet Mandala -** .not for beginners. Limit 10 people. Cost \$5.00. Hoops and cotton yarn will be supplied. Please bring a 3.75 mm crochet hook.
