Cancellations: Cancellations of registration made more than two weeks prior to the commencement of the camp will receive a full refund. Cancellations made less than two week prior to the commencement of camp will receive no refund, unless prior approval is given.

Directions: Travel north along Ruthven Street, and continue along the New England Highway in the direction of Crows Nest. Drive about 9 kms, then turn off at Recreation Reserve Road (Sign to James Byrne Centre), then take a sharp turn into James Byrne Road. Entrance to Centre is 2 km from the highway.

Covid 19. All Covid Safe practices will be in force during the weekend. Masks, gloves and hand sanitiser will be available throughout the weekend. Only 1 person per room is allowed in the accommodations, and participants cannot enter another participants' assigned area during the stay. Health Declarations will have to be signed by each attendee on arrival. Please make sure you are fit and well.

The James Byrne Centre's Dietary Information (as quoted from their information)

The Centre caters for special dietary requirements.

The Centre does not cater for lifestyle choices.

If special dietary requirements are necessary for a guest's wellbeing, the centre will meet such requirement but will require a doctor's or dietitian's certificate.

We believe that the menu selection will give everyone a choice of food to eat at each meal.

If you feel this would not suit you, and would like to bring your own food, give Betty or Joy a call to discuss this with them.

Workshop requirements:

1. **Crochet slippers** – bring along a crochet hook and 8 ply wool in two colours.
2. **Tie dyed/ice dyed tee-shirt.** Only one tee-shirt will be able to be dyed by participants. Cost \$10.00. Participants are to bring:
 - a. plastic tub with lid, approximately 31cm(L) x 22cm (W) x at least 10cm deep. Enough so it will hold the tee-shirt;
 - b. tee-shirt – can be long or short sleeved;
 - c. string or twine.
 - d. Plastic bag to carry tee shirt home to finish proving before washout.
3. **Wrapped Yarn coaster.** Core fibre will be supplied. Bring along scraps of handspun yarn/commercial yarn and a wool needle (it's a good way to use left over yarn). Cost \$5.00.
4. **Kokedama** – kit supplied. Cost \$10.00

Please note: the Crochet Slipper workshops will start at 9 am on Saturday. Those attending as a day visitor on Saturday, who want to do that workshop, will need to be at camp by then.
